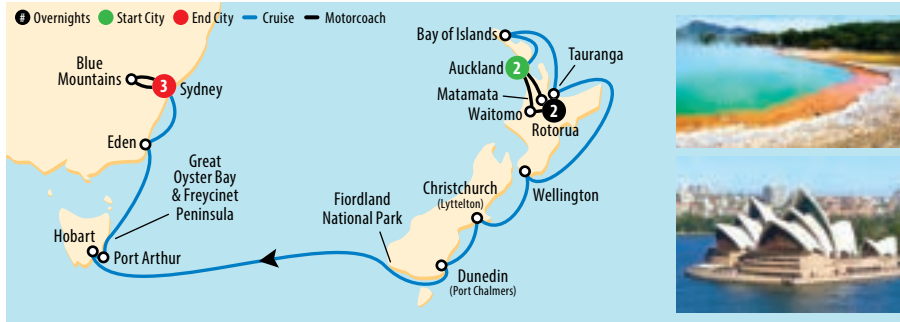

Day 1: Mon, Feb 21 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Alaska/Hawaiian Airlines.

Day 2: Tue, Feb 22 – AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive in Auckland. Welcome to the “land of the long white cloud,” New Zealand! Meet your Tour Director at the airport for a transfer to your hotel. A **Welcome Dinner** is included tonight at the hotel. SKYCITY AUCKLAND or Similar (1 Night) (D)

Day 3: Wed, Feb 23 – AUCKLAND – MATAMATA – ROTORUA. Depart Auckland and travel to a picturesque farm near Matamata, which was transformed into the **Hobbiton movie set** of the *Lord of the Rings* films, for a guided tour. Continue to Rotorua for a two-night stay. This evening, enjoy a **traditional Hangi concert and dinner**. Explore an ancient culture of the Māori. You’ll learn the history of the area, hear storytelling, be captivated by songs and dance, and experience the famous haka (war dance). Afterward, sit down in the whareni (ancestral meeting house) for an authentic Hangi dinner (roasted meats and vegetables cooked underground with hot stones) and be entertained with music and dancing. DISTINCTION ROTORUA HOTEL & CONFERENCE CENTRE or Similar (2 Nights) (B, D)

Day 4: Thur, Feb 24 – ROTORUA. Sightseeing in Rotorua includes the Agrodome, Te Wairoa Buried Village and Te Puia. Experience New Zealand’s sheep industry in person at **Agrodome**, where you will watch a sheep shearing demonstration, visit the farmyard nursery, and see the remarkable farm dogs as they demonstrate their ability to respond to commands and keep the sheep in line. The **Buried Village of Te Wairoa** is an award-winning heritage site that shows life before the volcanic eruption. **Te Puia** is Rotorua’s most prominent thermal area, with New Zealand’s largest geyser, boiling mud pools, and silica terraces. Lunch at The Stratosfare restaurant with a **Skyline Gondola ride**. (B, L)

Day 5: Fri, Feb 25 – ROTORUA – WAITOMO – AUCKLAND. Depart Rotorua and travel through the green pastoral region of Waikato to the famous **Waitomo Glowworm Caves**. Experience a guided tour through the limestone chambers and passages of the cavern. Take a **silent boat trip** through **Glowworm Grotto** as you glide quietly beneath the lights of thousands of glowworms suspended from the cave ceiling. Continue to Auckland. Dinner at a local restaurant. SKYCITY AUCKLAND or Similar (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 6: Sat, Feb 26 – AUCKLAND – EMBARK ROYAL PRINCESS. After breakfast, a guided tour of the city includes the Sky Tower, Auckland War Memorial Museum, Auckland Domain, and Māori Court. Dominating the Auckland skyline for over 28 years, the

328m-tall **Sky Tower** offers stunning 360° views across Tamaki Makaurau (the Māori-language name for Auckland). At 186m above street level, the main observation level offers views up to 80km in every direction. The **Auckland War Memorial Museum** is New Zealand’s earliest museum and widely regarded as one of the finest museums in the Southern Hemisphere and tells the story of New Zealand, its people, and its place in the Pacific. The land for the **Auckland Domain** was set aside in 1880 as a 200-acre public reserve. Developed around the cone of an extinct volcano, the Domain is now New Zealand’s oldest park. The **Māori Court** is New Zealand’s oldest and longest established specialist court, and is the only indigenous land court in the world. After a harbourside lunch, transfer to the cruise terminal for embarkation aboard your cruise on the luxurious Royal Princess. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Sun, Feb 27 – BAY OF ISLANDS, NEW ZEALAND. 7:00am – 5:00pm. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Mon, Feb 28 – TAURANGA, NEW ZEALAND. 6:30 am – 5:30 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Sat, Mar 11 – SYDNEY – DISEMBARK ROYAL PRINCESS. Your Tour Director will greet you upon disembarkation. Begin your stay in Sydney with a guided tour inside the world’s most recognizable sails, the **Sydney Opera House**, a miracle of architecture and engineering. It is a work of art that came into existence against impossible odds, and has become one of the busiest performing arts centers in the world. Working with new, rich audio-visual components, where images are projected onto the fabric of the building, your knowledgeable Guide will take you on an emotional journey, engrossing you in a story to rival any opera plot with its dramatic twists and turns. You will visit at least one of the venues, where there is a live performance every day. Some 1,500 performances, from opera to circus, rock, and cabaret, are staged each year. Audio headsets are included on this tour. See the **Botanical Gardens**, including a visit to **Mrs. Macquarie’s Chair**. Visit **Chinatown** with time to explore and shop. Evening is at your leisure. SWISSÔTEL SYDNEY or Similar (3 Nights) (B)

Day 21: Sun, Mar 12 – SYDNEY – EXCURSION TO THE BLUE MOUNTAINS. The **Blue Mountains** tour is a journey into the heart of a unique World Heritage Region. Your first stop of the day is at **Featherdale Wildlife Park**, home to kangaroos, emus, wombats, and koalas. Spend some time to wander at leisure. Enjoy lunch in the Blue Mountains. Blue Mountain sightseeing includes the **Three Sisters rock formation** and **Scenic World**, where you can ride the **Scenic Railway**, **Scenic Cableway**, and **Scenic Skyway**. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel. (B, L, D)

Day 22: Mon, Mar 13 – SYDNEY. Spend the morning at **The Rocks Market**. Held every Saturday and Sunday, The Rocks Market is a bustling market full of stalls with wares ranging from locally-designed fashion to handcrafted jewelry and beauty products. Leisurely stroll the cobblestone streets, meet local artists and photographers, grab a bite to eat from the many food vendors, or listen the live music being played. Enjoy a **Sydney Harbour Lunch Cruise**. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

Day 23: Tue, Mar 14 – SYDNEY – HONOLULU. Take a bird’s eye view of the city from **Sydney Tower**. Standing at 309m above the Sydney Central Business District (CBD), Sydney Tower is the tallest structure in Sydney and the second-tallest observation tower in the Southern Hemisphere. Although Auckland’s Sky Tower is taller, Sydney Tower’s main observation deck is 30m higher than the observation deck on Auckland’s Sky Tower. Continue to **Bondi Beach** and learn about the Lifesavers. With its white sands and reliable waves, Bondi Beach is one of Australia’s most well-known beaches. Easily recognizable by their iconic red and yellow uniforms, the Lifesavers are volunteers from the Bondi Surf Batheters’ Life Saving Club, that patrol the beach from October to April each year, preventing drownings and performing rescues. Enjoy lunch in the Darling Harbour area, followed by some free time to explore and shop. Transfer to the Sydney Airport for the flight home. Depart Sydney via Alaska/Hawaiian Airlines. Arrive in Honolulu the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B, L)
