Day 1: Fri, Feb 18 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Sat, Feb 19 – HONG KONG, CHINA – EMBARK OCEANIA RIVIERA. Arrive in Hong Kong. Transfer to pier and embark the Riviera. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 3: Sun, Feb 20 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Mon, Feb 21 – TAIPEI (KEELUNG), TAIWAN CHINA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. On this fascinating island visit the world's tallest building, the Chiang Kai Shek Memorial, the fabulous Palace Museum's vast collection of Chinese art and the lovely Bangka Lungshan Temple. Explore lovely Keelung's historic sites and Yeliu Park's astonishing rock formations. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Tue, Feb 22 – ISHIGAKI, JAPAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Discover this remote and picturesque island's lush mountains, beautiful beaches, and magnificent coral reef from island viewpoints. See the native palm forest and the lavishly decorated Chinese tomb. Step back in time and travel to the tiny island of Taketomi-jima with its treasured red-tile-roofed town where rural island heritage, including ox carts, is vividly alive. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Wed, Feb 23 – MIYAKOJIMA (HIRARA), JAPAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. This Japanese island paradise is known for its natural beauty and vibrant local culture. The Eastern Cape is a nationally-designated Place of Scenic Beauty with a spectacular view of the surrounding ocean. Stop by the beaches of Sunayama or Aragusuku for sunshine and snorkeling. A visit to the Shigira onsen hot springs will help you relax or take a ride across the expansive Ikema Bridge for a scenic drive across the beautiful blue waters. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Thur, Feb 24 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Fri, Feb 25 – KAGOSHIMA, JAPAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Visit the exquisite Iso-Teien Garden and its villa, built in 1660, and enjoy its gorgeous views before a short ferry ride to smoking Sakurajima for a close-up view of the volcano and its lava fields. Or journey into the countryside to Chiran and its well-preserved streets lined with samurai homes. Enjoy the beautiful landscape of Lake Ikeda and the stunning vistas of the Satsuma Peninsula. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Sat, Feb 26 – BEPPU, JAPAN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Backed by steep hills and mountains on the eastern coast of Kyushu Island, Beppu is known as Japan's top onsen hot spring resort city. Home to more than 2,000 onsens, this picturesque city gives you a chance to experience its hot springs, mud baths, steam baths and even traditional Japanese black sand baths. To top it off, eight unique hot springs, collectively named the "Onsen Hells," offer entertainingly distinctive attractions. On chilly days, visitors are treated to the otherworldly view of steam rising throughout the city. Since

Beppu is famously popular within Japan as a resort getaway, it's an ideal place to rub elbows with Japanese travelers. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Sun, Feb 27 – HIROSHIMA, JAPAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Visit the skeletal Atomic Bomb Dome, Peace Memorial Park, Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum, and the statue dedicated to the children who died after the atomic bomb was dropped on this city in 1945. Stroll through beautifully landscaped Hiroshima Gardens, visit the rebuilt Hiroshima Castle, or journey to the exquisite sacred island of Miyajima and see the extraordinary Itsukushima Shrine. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Mon, Feb 28 – KOCHI, JAPAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Not the typical Japanese city, small and compact Kochi has gained a well-deserved reputation for its exuberant, easy-going spirit, and vibrant food scene. The city is the birthplace of the legendary samurai Sakamoto Ryoma, who created an alliance that eventually brought down the Tokugawa Shogunate and is now commemorated in a memorial museum. In the city center, don't miss the well-preserved hilltop Kochi Castle to explore the grounds where the city was established in 1601. You might continue your downtown explorations at one of the many pedestrian shopping arcades or at a restaurant to try Kochi's most famous dish: katsuo-no-tataki, a savory dish of grilled, ponzu-marinated skipjack tuna or bonito fish. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Tue, Feb 29 – KYOTO (KOBE), JAPAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Visit the breathtaking temples and shrines of Japan's old imperial capital, Kyoto, or explore ancient Nara, the cradle of Japanese arts, literature and crafts, with its magnificent shrines and temples that predate Kyoto's. Stroll through Nara Park, famed for its deer and impressive Kasuga Grand Shrine. Then travel on to Osaka and its famed castle. In Kobe, visit historic Himeji Castle, a huge edifice built entirely of wood and tile. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Wed, Mar 01 – SHIMIZU, JAPAN. Arrive 12:00 pm. Depart 8:00 pm. In the shadow of Mt. Fuji, Shimizu is one of the most beautiful ports in Japan. Walk through the pine groves of Miho, home to a 650-year-old Japanese black pine, or enjoy spectacular views of Mt. Fuji from the lush, forested hill of Nihondaira. Take in the seascapes on a bay cruise, or learn of undersea delights at Japan's first sushi museum. For a historic angle, get a glimpse at feudal life in Japan in 200 B.C. at the archaeological site of Toro. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Thur, Mar 02 – TOKYO (YOKOHAMA), JAPAN – DISEMBARK OCEANIA RIVIERA – HONOLULU. Arrive 6:00 am. Disembark Riviera. Depart Tokyo. Return flight to Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
