Day 1: Sat, Jan 15 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Sun, Jan 16 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Mon, Jan 17 – BARCELONA, SPAIN – EMBARK OCEANIA ALLURA. Arrive in Barcelona. Transfer to pier and embark the Allura. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Tue, Jan 18 – PALMA DE MALLORCA, SPAIN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Explore this beautiful island beginning with the magnificent Seo Cathedral and Bellver Castle. See the windmills and impressive manor house in the verdant countryside. Discover the amazing natural wonders in the Drach Caves. And for romance, visit the former Carthusian monastery in Valldemosa, where George Sand and Chopin spent a winter. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Wed, Jan 19 – CARTAGENA, SPAIN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. This walled city has always been a major naval port due to its natural harbor and strategic location. Enjoy a hilltop view from Concepción Castle, which served as a fortress for the Carthaginians, Romans and other peoples who once occupied the city. Visit the 1st century B.C. Roman Theater, the remains of the 13th century Cathedral of Santa Maria and the Naval Museum. For modernist architecture, see the City Hall, Grand Hotel, and Casino. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Thur, Jan 20 – MALAGA, SPAIN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Spend a day in Granada seeing the magnificent Alhambra and Generalife Gardens, last stronghold of the Moors, or venture into the mountains to the picturesque Mijas, one of Andalusia's dazzling "white" towns. Explore delightful Malaga, its Alcazaba, Roman theater and beautiful cathedral, or discover the charming resorts of Marbella and Puerto Banus along the famed Costa del Sol. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Fri, Jan 21 – SEVILLE (CADIZ), SPAIN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Spend a fabulous day in Seville visiting the magnificent cathedral, climbing the famed Giralda Tower and strolling through the gorgeous Alcazar and its gardens. See the ceramic-encrusted Plaza de España and stroll through the alleys of Barrio de Santa Cruz. Or explore the Andalusian wine country and Jerez, the home of sherry. Don't miss the charm of Cadiz with its gracious squares, its flower-filled parks on the city bastions and its bustling markets. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Sat, Jan 22 – TANGIER, MOROCCO. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Explore the Mendoubia Gardens, which contain a fascinating banyan tree that is more than 800 years old. Or experience a more traditional Morocco in Tetouan, a mountain city of grace and culture and the location of the beautiful white royal palace. The Caves of Hercules are nine miles west of Tangier in the Cap Spartel area; it is a place of great beauty and archaeological significance. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Sun, Jan 23 – MELILLA, SPAIN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Appreciate the unique nature of graceful Melilla, an autonomous Spanish city on the African coast carved out of Morocco. Soak up the Triángulo del Oro district's stylish architecture, which outside of Barcelona showcases Spain's largest collection of modernism buildings, the architectural style epitomized by Antoni Gaudí. In fortified Old Melilla, stroll cobbled lanes sandwiched between defensive walls and step into the Cuevas des Coventico, natural caves used as a hiding place throughout the ages. Witness the city's captivating mix of cultures at the Mercadillo de Melilla, where savvy shoppers throng in search of colorful Moroccan goods. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Mon, Jan 24 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Tue, Jan 25 – CAGLIARI (SARDINIA), ITALY. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Savor this delightful old city spread over seven hills and its many attractions reflecting the influence of its numerous rulers. Climb to the citadel and visit the fabulous archaeological museum, Roman ruins and Pisan towers, early Byzantine churches, the cathedral, or the botanic gardens. Enjoy the nearby beach or discover the remains of Sardinia's ancient, enigmatic Nuraghic culture and their stone towers built in scenic locations all over Sardinia. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Wed, Jan 26 – TUNIS (LA GOULETTE), TUNISIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Meander through Tunis' opulent, historic medina with its winding alleys and souks. Visit the superb Bardo Museum with its spectacular Roman mosaics or the lovely whitewashed village of Sidi Bou Saïd, perched on a cliff above the sea, a charming spot of cobbled streets, flower-filled courtyards, and ornate window grills painted deep blue. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Thur, Jan 27 – TRAPANI (SICILY), ITALY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Perched on a low-lying, palazzi-dotted promontory on Sicily's western coast, Trapani reveals a hint of its medieval past in its historic core's tightly knit maze of narrow streets. The rebuilt 14th century Cathedral of St. Lawrence and the grand Sanctuary of the Annunciation, which holds a fascinating regional museum, are nuggets well worth a visit. Wandering the Villa Margherita public gardens makes for a relaxing afternoon. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Fri, Jan 28 – VALLETTA, MALTA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Discover the myriad of cultural layers of Malta, from its amazing prehistoric temples at Tarxien to beautiful walled medieval Mdina, nearby Rabat, and Marsaxlokk, a colorful fishing village. Admire the stunning scenery and wander through imposing churches and down the streets of fortified towns where the Knights of St. John once held sway. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Sat, Jan 29 – MESSINA (SICILY), ITALY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Visit beautiful Taormina and marvel at its famous Greek theater and the stunning view of Mount Etna. Explore lovely medieval Messina with its historic churches and the cathedral where it is rumored Richard the Lionheart worshipped in 1190. Or discover ancient Tyndaris, founded in 396 B.C., with its fine mosaics, Roman baths and impressive theater overlooking the sea. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Sun, Jan 30 – SALERNO, ITALY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Experience the sublime atmosphere of the towns and villages that punctuate the Amalfi Coast, a UNESCO World Heritage site for its quintessentially Mediterranean scenery. Stroll along Salerno's elegant lungomare, a shoreside promenade with far-reaching views of the sea and the mountains beyond. From Amalfi's quaint Piazza Duomo, walk up ancient steps to the stunning Cathedral of Saint Andrew, while in kaleidoscopic Positano, take postcard-worthy photos of houses precariously perched on the shoreside cliffs. Behold the splendid Renaissance palazzi of Sorrento, float above the emerald green waters of a fabled sea cave, and take in extraordinary panoramas of the ruggedly beautiful coastline from hilltop Ravello. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Mon, Jan 31 – ROME (CIVITAVECCHIA), ITALY – DISEMBARK OCEANIA ALLURA – HONOLULU. Arrive 7:00 am. Disembark Allura. Depart Rome. Return flight to Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
