Day 1: Monday, April 3, 2028 Depart Honolulu - Overnight Flight
Your tour begins with an overnight flight to Dubai.

Day 2: Tuesday, April 4, 2028 Overnight Flight Continue on your journey to Dubai

Day 3: Wednesday, April 5, 2028 Dubai, United Arab Emirates
Arrive in Dubai, one of the world's most exciting destinations. Your day is at leisure to relax or explore this dynamic and cosmopolitan city independently. As one of the seven emirates of the United Arab Emirates, Dubai is considered the shopping capital of the Middle East. With its many world-famous man-made structures built in recent years, Dubai is a must-see destination for any traveler and will surely be an experience you will always remember.

Day 4: Thursday, April 6, 2028 Dubai Today, take a 4x4 vehicle for a light dune drive through the desert.* Then, visit the Al Fahidi Historical Neighborhood where a local guide will take you on a walking tour to see the sites. Along the way, enjoy an Arabian coffee or tea before heading to Sheikh Mohammad Cultural Centre of Understanding (SMCCU). While visiting SMCCU, enjoy a cultural Arabic lunch followed by a Q & A session hosted by a local. In the afternoon, venture across the creek in a private *Abra* and visit the Spice and Gold Souk to get a closer look at local life and culture found in Dubai. The rest of the day is yours at leisure. (B, L)

Day 5: Friday, April 7, 2028 Dubai This morning, take an optional tour to Burj Khalifa – the world's tallest building. Then, visit the Etihad Museum which tells the story and history of the founding of the United Arab Emirates. This afternoon, visit Madinat Souk – a labyrinthine Arabian bazaar of shops and eateries before heading to the Al Shindagha Museum, an open-air heritage museum located in traditional Emirati homes on the waterfront. (B)

Day 6: Saturday, April 8, 2028 Dubai - Delhi, India Board your flight to Delhi. Your tour begins in Delhi, which features a bustling energy, age-old monuments, and an all-encompassing vitality that courses its way through the busy streets. Experience everything this dynamic metropolis has to offer, from modern New Delhi to historic Old Delhi. There is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. Dinner tonight is on your own. (B)

Day 7: Sunday, April 9, 2028 Delhi Start your morning at the expansive Humayun's Tomb, one of the best-preserved Mughal monuments dating back to the 1500s. This sprawling complex inspired countless mausoleums, including the legendary Taj Mahal. Enjoy some free time in the afternoon to explore on your own. Gather with your group in the evening for a welcome dinner featuring Indian specialties. (B, D)

Day 8: Monday, April 10, 2028 Delhi Cut through Old Delhi's buzzing streets on a rickshaw – your mode of transportation for an exhilarating tour of Old Delhi. See the city's friendly vendors as you travel down narrow streets and busy corridors. Visit Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in India, and stand in awe before its iconic red sandstone towers. Your exploration of New Delhi continues on a journey by the city's famous monuments, including the India Gate and Parliament building. (B, L)

Day 9: Tuesday, April 11, 2028 Delhi - Jaipur Wish the city goodbye and embark on a scenic drive through the countryside. Stop for lunch in a local restaurant before arriving in Jaipur, the "Pink City." See Hawa Mahal, the former home of a *maharaja* (Indian prince). Marvel at the city's architectural brilliance as you stroll through the heart of the old city during your free time. (B, L)

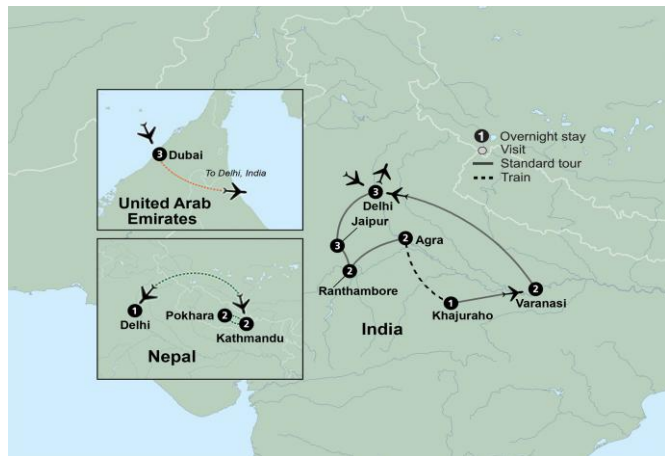
Day 10: Wednesday, April 12, 2028 Jaipur Take in the extensive palace complex of Amber Fort, India's former seat of power. Head to the palace by means of a vintage jeep, scaling the hills overlooking Jaipur. In the evening, get to know a local family as you join them for a hosted dinner in their home. (B, D)

Day 11: Thursday, April 13, 2028 Jaipur Experience an **Impact Moment** as you explore the secrets hidden in the walled city of Jaipur on an eco-friendly e-rickshaw. With Pink City Rickshaw Company, which employs women from low-income households, you'll get a peek into the soul of the old city as your driver steers the way. Continue your exploration of the beautiful city, starting with the City Palace. Nearby, take in the impeccable masonry of the Jantar Mantar – the world's oldest stone sundial. The afternoon is yours to discover Jaipur however you please. (B)

Day 12: Friday, April 14, 2028 Jaipur - Ranthambore National Park Travel to Ranthambore National Park where we will seek out tigers in their natural habitat. Learn about Project Tiger's conservation efforts and the impact the organization has had on the Ranthambore sanctuary. Connect with a naturalist, introducing you to India's extensive wildlife. This afternoon, you may also choose to join an optional hike up to the historic Ranthambore Fort for sweeping views of the park. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Saturday, April 15, 2028 Ranthambore Begin your day early and board a canter (open-air truck) to embark on your initial game drive. Seek out barking deer, Indian gazelles, and exotic birdlife. Follow the tigers' paths in search of the sanctuary's renowned wildlife. Then, **it's your choice!** Enjoy some leisure time to relax at the hotel and explore your surroundings at your own pace **-OR-** take a short trip for an **Impact Moment** at Dastkar Ranthambore, a social enterprise renowned for empowering local women artisans. No matter what you choose, return to the wild for another chance to seek out marsh crocodiles, sloth bears, and the park's famous Bengal tigers. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Sunday, April 16, 2028 Ranthambore - Agra Today, we set out at the break of day as we make our way to Agra, a city rich with the splendors of the past. Along the way, visit the impressive Abhaneri step well. Built over 1,000 years ago, it is an architectural marvel hidden from visitors until recently. Then, stop for lunch and get another taste of local flavors. Home to stone forts and marble mausoleums, Agra features a lively culture and picture-perfect architecture. This evening you may choose to join an optional excursion by tuk-tuk to explore Itmad ud Daula and Mahtab Bagh, where you'll get your first glimpse of the Taj Mahal. (B, L)

Day 15: Monday, April 17, 2028 Agra The Taj Mahal, a stunning vision in white marble and sandstone, was built as an expression of love by Emperor Shah Jahan. Experience the romantic spirit of the Taj Mahal in the early morning, when the colors of the sky dance on the bright façade and shimmer in its reflective pool. Visit Agra Fort, the seat of the Mughal Empire. During an **Impact Moment**, enjoy lunch at Sheroes' Hangout – a café that empowers female survivors of violence, allowing them to reclaim their lives through employment and sisterhood. (B, L)

Day 16: Tuesday, April 18, 2028 Agra - Khajuraho Another adventure awaits! Start your morning with a train ride on the Vande Bharat Express from Agra to Khajuraho. In the shadow of the Vindhya mountain range, find a city of stone temples and mystifying sculptures. Make the most of time at leisure this afternoon to explore the area on your own. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Wednesday, April 19, 2028 Khajuraho - Varanasi Take in the Chandela Temple complex, home to unparalleled temple architecture and intricate stone carvings. Fly to Varanasi – India's holiest city – where spiritual energy radiates from the ground up. Sail along the Ganges River and pass by the *ghats* (banks) where locals wade into the river. From the Dasaswamedh Ghat, enjoy a reserved seat to experience the Ganga Aarti ceremony as it illuminates the night sky. (B)

Day 18: Thursday, April 20, 2028 Varanasi Take advantage of a morning boat ride for an opportunity to see the sunrise on the Ganges River. Travel to Sarnath, where Siddhartha Gautama – later known as Buddha – gave his first sermon in the 6th century B.C. Discover this holy site and gain insight into the country's divine past. Celebrate your adventure through India alongside new friends at a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 19: Friday, April 21, 2028 Varanasi - Delhi Enjoy a morning at leisure before flying back to Delhi. Continue onward and create memories that will last a lifetime. Enjoy a morning at leisure before flying back to Delhi, where you may enjoy the remainder of the day as you please. (B)

Day 20: Saturday, April 22, 2028 Delhi - Kathmandu, Nepal After spending the night in Delhi, your adventure continues as you board your flight to Nepal. Immerse yourself in the energy of Kathmandu, Nepal's vibrant capital that will captivate senses. With an expert local guide, discover the beloved Thamel neighborhood, mingling amongst locals and mountain climbers alike. Perhaps you'll chat with a street vendor or pop into an inviting shop, perusing the goods for the perfect souvenir. Then, enjoy a discussion with an Everest climber. Finally, get a taste of the local flavors during dinner in a nearby restaurant. (B, D)

Day 21: Sunday, April 23, 2028 Kathmandu Perhaps you will take an optional early-morning flightseeing tour of iconic Mount Everest, getting an up-close look at the world's highest peak. Today, visit Patan Darbar Square (UNESCO), a historic temple complex, and make your way through the square to visit with Kumari, a local girl who is worshipped as the living incarnation of a goddess. Attend a private audience with the revered girl in her temple and take part in a blessing ceremony. Stop for lunch at a local restaurant before spending time at Bodhnath Stupa, an iconic Himalayan temple. (B, L)

Day 22: Monday, April 24, 2028 Kathmandu - Pokhara Today, travel to Pokhara, the gateway to trekking in the Himalayas. This area is known for its stunning scenery and views of the Annapurna mountain range. Wander through the Kaskikot Village and relax at your lodge set among the hills, taking in the 360-degree views of the surrounding mountains. (B, L)

Day 23: Tuesday, April 25, 2028 Pokhara This morning, you have another opportunity to see the vast mountains up close on an optional helicopter flight to Annapurna Base Camp. A visit to the International Mountain Museum in Pokhara will explore the history and development of mountaineering activities all over the world, including those in the Himalayas. Explore Pokhara by boat and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Tonight, celebrate the end of your adventure in the Himalayan nation of Nepal. (B, L, D)

before you travel back through the winding roads and hills to Kathmandu. Board your flight to Delhi, where you may stay overnight or for a few hours depending on your return flight home. (B, L)

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until September 30, 2026 , valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with no more than 20 travelers on this tour where a smaller group setting means a more personal travel experience.

*The desert safari experience is not private. If less than 6 travelers are booked on this extension, the vehicles will be shared with other travelers.

For the safety and well-being of our travelers, children under the age of 13 will not be allowed to join us on this tour. Contact us with any questions at time of booking.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Unfortunately, wheelchairs cannot be accommodated on this trip. In addition, travelers who require assistance walking or who travel with oxygen tanks will not fully enjoy this trip, and we strongly recommend a different tour.

When traveling in India, you will encounter full days of sightseeing, frequently in warm temperatures.

Summer temperatures can reach 104°F (40°C) during the day, with morning and evening temperatures around 77°F (25°C).

Winter temperatures will average around 57°F (14°C). Early morning and evening temperatures may range between 46°F and 55°F (8 °C and 13°C).

In order to experience sights in the best light conditions or to have the best opportunity for animal viewing, this tour has five days with starts before 7:00 a.m.

Wildlife sightings cannot be guaranteed.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple accommodations are not available.

Due to weather conditions, airlines may cancel the flight between Khajuraho and Varanasi. Should this occur, you will travel by coach taking approximately 8.5 hours, including stops.

Internal flights are required in order to participate on this tour and are included in the final price, quoted at time of booking.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports and visas are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require a minimum of 6 months passport validity from date of return home. An eVisa is required for travel to India at your expense and can be obtained prior to departure by visiting <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/evisa>. Rates and fees can change at any time based on governing authority.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

Each traveler is responsible for proper documentation and inoculations that may be required and/or recommended to participate on this tour. Please contact your local travel clinic or personal physician for specific details on the destinations you are traveling to and from.

Please be aware that if your flight schedule is via Dubai or if you are stopping over in Dubai and are carrying narcotic drugs, controlled or semi-controlled drugs, then you will be required to complete an electronic form prior to entering the country, to obtain approval to carry medication. Please use the link <https://mohap.gov.ae/en/w/approve-emergency-drugs-and-psychotropic-materials> to view the guidelines. A user's guide is available to explain the application and the supporting documents required. For regular prescription or over-the-counter medication, no prior approval is necessary.

Dubai Travel Requirements:

For US, UK, Australia, New Zealand, and Canadian citizens, no advance visa arrangement is required to visit the UAE when your stay is less than 30 days. Simply disembark your flight at Dubai International Airport and proceed to Immigration where your passport will be stamped with a 30-day visit visa free of charge. Rates can be changed at any time based on governing authority.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

Breakfast is not provided on the last morning for travelers leaving before the hotel breakfast room opens.

Nepal Travel Requirements:

A visa is required for US, Canadian, Australian and New Zealand citizens traveling to Nepal and can be obtained at the airport upon arrival by using the Kiosk machines; however, to avoid lengthy delays, we recommend travelers pre-fill the visa form online no more than 15 days prior to your arrival into Nepal. To pre-fill the online 'Tourist Visa' form, please go to www.nepaliport.immigration.gov.np. Once you have completed the form, you'll receive a submission receipt that you must print out and bring with you for acquiring your visa. The completed visa form is valid for 15 days and becomes invalid after that. The visa fee is approximately \$30 US Dollars.

An Arrival Card is also required and can be obtained on arrival. This card is typically provided by the airline during your flight or can be picked up at the immigration desk upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport.

If obtaining visa upon arrival, carry a passport photo as it is required for the visa. Local currency or USD is accepted and should be small, clean bills as oftentimes change is not available. Visa rates are approximate and can be changed at any time based on governing authority.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

Hop aboard a tuk tuk and set out to discover Itmad-ud-Daula, often called the “Baby Taj.” Built entirely of white marble, this beautifully crafted Mughal mausoleum is considered a precursor to the Taj Mahal. Smaller and more serene, it offers a peaceful, less-visited glimpse into the artistry and design that inspired India’s most famous monument. Continue to Mahtab Bagh, the tranquil “Moonlight Garden” across the Yamuna River from the Taj Mahal. From this scenic vantage point, take in a distant yet picture-perfect view of the Taj at sunset and watch as the marble façade glows warmly in the fading light — an ideal moment to capture photos. Afterward, return to the city for dinner at a local restaurant, where you’ll enjoy regional flavors and unwind after an evening of history, architecture, and beautiful scenery. *Duration: Approximately 3 hours.* Please note a minimum of 2 passengers is required. Transportation is not included.

Hike Ranthambore Fort

Venture to the amazing vantage point of Ranthambore Fort, a fortress atop a hill within a prominent tiger reserve. Hike up the steps of the 10th-century fort enclosed by a magnificent stone wall. Explore its elaborate ruins, including palaces, monuments, and temples. See the daily rituals that take place at the famous Trinetra Ganesha Temple, dedicated to the beloved elephant god. Enjoy a traditional tea or coffee with cookies during your exploration.
