Day 1: Tue, Dec 02 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Wed, Dec 03 — MIAMI, FLORIDA — EMBARK VISTA. Arrive in Florida. Transfer to the port of Miami for embarkation on the Oceania Vista. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 3: Thur, Dec 04 - AT SEA.

Day 4: Fri, Dec 05 – PORT ROYAL, JAMAICA. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Steeped in pirate tales, Port Royal is one of the oldest and most historic regions of Jamaica. The port city rose to prominence as one of the largest European cities in the New World in the 1600s and quickly became the infamous stomping ground of pirates such as Sir Henry Morgan, Calico Jack and Blackbeard. A visit to Fort Charles, built between 1650 and 1660, and its Maritime Museum offers a look at Jamaica's storied colonial past. And just a short drive away, Jamaica's cultural heart and capital city of Kingston offers a plethora of museums, art galleries and street markets, plus deep-seated musical and culinary heritage. Those looking for a sun-drenched playground will delight in Lime Cay, a white-sand islet just offshore Port Royal. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Sat, Dec 06 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Sun, Dec 07 — SANTA MARTA, COLOMBIA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 am. From the mangroves of Ciénaga Grande to the beaches of Tayrona National Park, Santa Marta offers a multitude of thrilling adventures. The oldest city in Colombia, it abounds with Spanish colonial charm, including one of the first basilicas built in Latin America, the Cathedral of Santa Marta. To learn of ancient history, explore the Ciudad Perdida, or "Lost City," believed to have been founded 650 years before Machu Picchu. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Mon, Dec 08 — CARTAGENA, COLOMBIA. Arrive 6:00 am. Depart 1:00 pm. Take a scenic drive through the residential area of Manga and admire the beautiful mansions. Explore the Castillo San Felipe de Barajas, a fort that was once the most important military structure built in Latin America. Enjoy a boat ride to the Islas del Rosario and continue to the island of San Martín de Pajarales to visit the aquarium. Board a beautiful Spanish galleon, a replica of a 17th century sailing ship, for a cruise of the inner bay of Cartagena. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Tue, Dec 09 — TRANSIT THE PANAMA CANAL. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Wed, Dec 10 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Thur, Dec 11 — PUNTARENAS, COSTA RICA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Be awed by the spectacular rainforest canopy, whether you walk through it or ride an aerial tram. Discover breathtaking waterfalls, butterfly gardens and a cloud forest. Watch for curious monkeys and brilliantly colored birds. Ride horseback through a rare virgin tropical dry forest. Or enjoy a scenic drive to San Jose and see this charming city and its sights. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Fri, Dec 12 — SAN JUAN DEL SUR, NICARAGUA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. One of Nicaragua's most popular vacation destinations, San Juan del Sur offers an exciting mix of local culture and tourist

activities. Enjoy horseback riding, sailing, and fishing along the Pacific coastline. Sail above the forests on a tree canopy tour located in the foothills behind the city or simply spend the day relaxing on the beautiful beaches. (B, L D)

Day 12: Sat, Dec 13 – ACAJUTLA, EL SALVADOR. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Though it boasts the largest industrial seaport in El Salvador, Acajutla is not heavily frequented by cruise ships and thus gives visitors an authentic look at life along the Pacific coast of Central America. Cast your line on a deep-sea fishing expedition, or take a tour to see the country's active volcanoes, Mayan ruins or coffee plantations. For more adventurous souls, a zip line canopy tour above the Apaneca jungle provides thrills. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Sun, Dec 14 – PUERTO QUETZAL, GUATEMALA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 2:00 pm. Drive into the mountains to beautiful old Antigua, once the country's colonial capital, and discover its lovely bougainvilleadraped buildings and breathtaking views of emerald volcanoes. Travel to famed Lake Atitlan and step back in time as you encounter the indigenous people in all of their finery still living along the lakeshore. Or better yet, fly to Flores and experience the magnificent and enigmatic Mayan temples and palaces of the Tikal complex, surrounded by jungle. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Mon, Dec 15 – HUATULCO, MEXICO. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Huatulco has one of the most important ecosystems in Mexico with a myriad of beaches on nine bays. Surrounded by lush lowland jungle vegetation, the beaches are known for their blue-green waters, mild waves, white sands, and spectacular scuba diving and snorkeling. Tangolunda Bay offers one of the best golf courses on the Pacific coast. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Wed, Dec 17 – PUERTO VALLARTA, MEXICO. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Go whale-watching, snorkeling, rainforest ziplining, deep-sea fishing, or horseback riding. Or enjoy world-class shopping, tequila-tasting and people-watching along the Malecon, which also boasts sculptures created by world famous artists. (B, L, D)
