MIYAKO HOTEL KYOTO HACHIJO - 4-STARS (3 NIGHTS):

This is one of the largest hotels in Kansai, with an excellent location in front of the Shinkansen, JR and Kintetsu Kyoto Stations. In the courtyard between the main building and the south wing, a glass chapel "Aqua Crystal" is arranged, and a healing space that spreads away from the hustle and bustle of the city while in front of the station.



HOTEL GRANVIA OSAKA – 4-STARS (2 NIGHTS): Located in the center of the spirited and historic city of Osaka, the hotel offers guests a sophisticated retreat and direct connection to JR Osaka train lines! Guests at this will experience unparalleled hospitality, fine and casual dining, spacious guestroom accommodations, and the finest in services and amenities.

Day 1: Wed, May 20 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #791 at 11:35 am.

Day 2: Thur, May 21 – KANSAI – KYOTO. Arrive at the Kansai International Airport at 3:40 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Kyoto. MIYAKO HOTEL KYOTO HACHIJO (3 Nights).

Day 3: Fri, May 22 – KYOTO – ARASHIYAMA – KYOTO. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, embark on a full day of discovery! First visit **Tenryuji Temple**, the most important temple in Kyoto's Arashiyama district. It was ranked first among the city's five great Zen temples, and is now registered as a world heritage site. Next, explore the famous **Arashiyama Bamboo Forests**. Then spend some time shopping at **Arashiyama Shopping Street** for some of the world-famous bamboo products while enjoying lunch on your own. Next, explore a **depachika**; markets located on the basement level of department stores. These popular shopping destinations offer a wide variety of ready-to-eat foods like side dishes, bentos, and sweets, along with fresh ingredients such as meat and fish. Spend some time shopping and dining (on your own) before walking back to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 4: Sat, May 23 — KYOTO. Full day at leisure. Your hotel is surrounded by department stores, specialty stores, and restaurants. A perfect day to fulfill your shopping list. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 5: Sun, May 24 — KYOTO — OSAKA. After breakfast, enjoy a **full day of hands-on activities and SHOPPING!** Start the day learning how **surikomi yuzen (brush dyed yuzen)** is done. Since the patterns are dyed by placing a paper stencil over an item, you can make an authentic piece, even if this is your first time. A great souvenir of this trip! Next, visit **Nishiki Market**, also known as "Kyoto's Kitchen" is a narrow, five block long shopping street lined by more than one hundred shops and restaurants. Specializes in all things food related, like fresh seafood, produce, knives and cookware, and is a great place to find seasonal foods and Kyoto specialties, such as Japanese sweets, pickles, dried seafood and sushi. Then explore one of the most popular shopping streets in all of Kyoto, **Teramachi Shopping Arcade**, located right in the middle of downtown Kyoto. Teramachi Shopping Arcade is a fascinating blend of history and modernity — from long established stores selling kimonos and traditional crafts to stores offering the latest trendy fashion

items. Finally enjoy some time shopping on **Gion Street**, Kyoto's most famous geisha district, located around Shijo Avenue between Yasaka Shrine in the east and the Kamo River in the west. It is filled with shops, restaurants and ochaya (teahouses), where geiko (Kyoto dialect for geisha) and maiko (geiko apprentices) entertain. Transfer to the hotel in Osaka for an evening of leisure. Day 6: Mon, May 25 – OSAKA. Full day at leisure. Your hotel is surrounded by department stores, specialty stores, and restaurants. A perfect day to fulfill your shopping list. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 7: Tue, May 26 — OSAKA — KANSAI — HONOLULU. After hotel checkout, start the day with a visit to Kuromon Ichiba Market, a lively covered market which stretches for 580 meters in Osaka's Chuo Ward. The market is famous for its fresh seafood, fruits and vegetables, meats, dried fish, pickles, and confectionery. Many stalls will prepare, cook, and serve their food to you right on the spot! An excellent place to stroll, sample, and snack on a delicious variety of fresh market foods. Next, visit **Dotonbori**, one of Osaka's most popular tourist destinations, this street runs parallel to the Dotonbori Canal. It is a popular shopping and entertainment district and is also known as a food destination. Then enjoy time at **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** — which is considered Osaka's premier shopping center. Approximately 600 meters long, this area is unique as it combines chain retail stores and trendy boutiques with expensive department stores and top designer fashion labels. At 300 meters tall, **Abeno Harukas** was once the tallest skyscraper in Japan and houses a department store, art museum, hotel and an observation deck. The observation deck, called "Harukas 300," occupies the building's top three floors (floors 58 to 60). With large floor-to-ceiling glass panels all around, the 60th floor offers 360 degree views of Osaka. The **Kintetsu Department Store** located within Abeno Harukas is the largest department store in Japan — covering over 100,000 square meters of retail space, and comprising of two buildings: the tower and the wing. The tower building carries many international brands, has two floors dedicated to interior and furnishing, two food floors in the basement, as well as three floors of restaurants. Over at the wing building, shops marketed under the "Solaha" branding are geared towards a younger clientele. There is also a floor for sports and travel goods, as well as a kids bookstore. Enjoy free time to explore both the observation deck and department store. A final shopping stop will be made at **AEON MALL Rinku Sennan** before transferring to the airport for the return flight home. Depart Kansai International Airport and arrive in Honolulu the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
