Day 1: Fri, Oct 17 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via United Airlines flt #1176 at 11:30 pm.

Day 2: Sat, Oct 18 — IN TRANSIT. Arrive in San Francisco at 7:48 am. Depart San Francisco via United Airlines flt #507 at 4:30 pm.

Day 3: Sun, Oct 19 — ROME, ITALY. Arrive in Rome at 1:20 pm. Welcome to Rome, "the Eternal City." After entry formalities, meet your Globus Tour Director at the airport. Begin your time in Rome at the **Fontana di** Trevi (the Trevi Fountain), Rome's largest and most beautiful fountain. Will you join the millions of visitors a year that throw a coin into the fountain? Remember to throw the coin with your right hand, over your left shoulder. Next, visit the **Pantheon**, which is not only the best preserved ancient Roman monument in the world, but it's also the most copied. Originally built as a temple in ancient Rome, the structure you see today was actually reconstructed around 126 AD. The Piazza Navona is one of the most beautiful squares in Rome, home of some of its most famous fountains, including the Fountain of the Four Rivers and the Fountain of Neptune. Finally, you will learn to cook just like "Nonna" (Grandma) using inherited recipes. You are welcomed with drinks and antipasti to Passetto. The chef will teach the class how to make two fresh pastas in a state-of-the-art-kitchen. But what to stuff or adorn the pastas with? This will depend on the season, and you are welcome to specify if there is a specific pasta dish they would like to learn to make. To finish the class will come together in the dining room to enjoy what has been prepared with local wines and coffee. A lovely evening in Rome. After dinner, transfer to the hotel. AMERICAN PALACE EUR or Similar (2 Nights) (D)

Day 4: Mon, Oct 20 — ROME. Rome will be celebrating the Jubilee in 2025; a holy year that's a major milestone for the Catholic Church. The Jubilee is a time for spiritual renewal and cultural celebration, and it's marked by a pilgrimage of millions of people to Rome. The Jubilee begins on December 24, 2024 and ends on January 6, 2026. Take part in the pilgrimage as you visit the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the church of Santa Maria Maggiore, one of the four major papal basilicas as well as one of the Seven Pilgrim Churches of Rome and the largest Marian church in Rome. Take a guided tour of the inside of the church, including the Upper Area (Loggia, Popes' Hall, Bernini's staircase, and Liberian Historical Museum), Basilica and Archaeological Area. Next, visit the Colosseum, the largest amphitheater ever built. It could hold an estimated 50,000 to 80,000 spectators — with an average audience size of 65,000. It was used for gladiatorial contests, animal hunts, executions, and re-enactments of famous battles. Although substantially damaged by earthquakes and stone robbers, the Colosseum is still a renowned symbol of Imperial Rome and is listed as one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. The Roman Forum was the scene of public meetings, courts of law, and gladiatorial combats in republican times, and was lined with shops and open-air markets. It was the most important forum during ancient Rome and is situated on the low ground between the Palatine and Capitoline Hills. The **Arch of Constantine** marks the first time a Roman emperor celebrated victory over fellow Romans so blatantly. The 20 meter high monumental arch is situated between the Colosseum and the Temple of Venus and Roma — making it a highly visible reminder of Constantine's triumph. The **Palatine Hill** was once considered the cradle of the Italian capital and believed to be inhabited since 1,000 BC. The site is now mainly a large open-air museum. Enjoy lunch at a local eatery. After lunch, experience "**Welcome to Rome**," a **multimedia show** that allows you to discover the history and development of Rome throughout its 2,700 year history. Return the hotel for an evening of leisure (B, L)

Day 5: Tue, Oct 21 – ROME – EMBARK NORWEGIAN EPIC. After breakfast, explore Rome's secret underground world on this incredible guided tour into the vast **labyrinth of catacombs** with their ancient tombs and burial chambers. Depending on availability, you may visit the Catacombs of San Callisto, a huge network of subterranean galleries about 17 kilometers long and 20 meters deep that contains the crypt of nine popes, and early Christian frescoes and paintings. You may also explore the Catacombs of San Domitilla, the oldest catacomb, with features a 2nd century fresco of *The Last Supper* and is accessed by passing through a 4th century church. Afterward, visit the **Papal Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls**, one of Rome's four ancient, major Papal basilicas. Enjoy lunch at an authentic Italian restaurant. Then transfer to the Cruise Terminal and embark the NORWEGIAN EPIC. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Sat, Nov 01 – DISEMBARK NORWEGIAN EPIC – ROME, ITALY. After disembarkation, meet your Globus Tour Director. First stop this morning is at **Mercato di Campagna Amica del Circo Massimo**, Rome's Saturday Farmer's Market. New dishes are offered every week highlighting the current in season harvest. Enjoy lunch here (on your own). After lunch, learn about one of Italy's most famous and beloved Renaissance Men, Leonardo Da Vinci at the **Leonardo Da Vinci Museum**. Experience more than 50 working and interactive Da Vinci inventions. Enjoy dinner at a local Italian restaurant, before arriving at the hotel. AMERICAN PALACE EUR or Similar (2 Nights) (B, D)

Day 17: Sun, Nov 02 — ROME. Trade the bustle of Rome for the serenity of the surrounding **Castelli Romani hill towns** on this engaging half-day guided excursion with dinner. Begin by traveling southeast out of Rome into the volcanic Alban Hills, arriving first in magnificent Castel Gandolfo. Overlooking Lake Albano, this is considered one of the most beautiful towns in Italy — and it's easy to see why the popes used it as a summer vacation retreat. After a short stop here, proceed via Marino and Grottaferrata to nearby Frascati, renowned as an artistic center and for its production of white wine. Relax at a rustic tavern near the charming market square for a delightful dinner featuring delectable regional dishes, unlimited white wine, and festive accordion music. (B, D)

Day 18: Mon, Nov 03 — ROME — LOS ANGELES. Depart the hotel with a "grab and go" breakfast and transfer to the airport. Depart Rome via United Airlines flt #971 at 9:45 am and arrive in Chicago at 1:05 pm. After entry formalities, enjoy some leisure time and the chance to stretch your legs before the next flight. Depart Chicago via United Airlines flt #1967 at 6:15 pm and arrive in Los Angeles at 8:48 pm. Transfer to an airport hotel for the evening. LOS ANGELES AIRPORT HOTEL (1 Night) (B)

Day 19: Tue, Nov 04 – LOS ANGELES – HONOLULU. Transfer from the hotel to the airport. Depart Los Angeles via United Airlines flt #1158 at 8:35 am and arrive in Honolulu at 12:31 pm. Aloha and welcome home!
