**Day 1: Fri** – HONOLULU – SEATTLE, WASHINGTON. Depart Honolulu. Arrive Seattle. Transfer to the airport hotel. RADISSON HOTEL SEATTLE AIRPORT (1 Night)

**Day 2: Sat** – SEATTLE – EMBARK ROYAL PRINCESS. After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the Port of Seattle. Board the luxurious Royal Princess. Enjoy the Sail Away Party! (Light B, D)

**Day 3: Sun** – AT SEA. Enjoy a scenic day at sea as you explore your ship. (B, L, D)

**Day 4: Mon** – JUNEAU, ALASKA. Arrive 1:00 pm. Depart 9:15 pm. In 1880, it was slow going for Joe Juneau and Richard Harris as they searched for gold with the help of Native guides. After climbing mountains, forging streams, and facing countless difficulties, they found nuggets “as large as beans.” From their discovery came three of the largest gold mines in the world. By the end of WWII, more than \$150 million in gold had been mined. Eventually the mines closed, but the town Joe Juneau founded became the capital of Alaska and the business of gold was replaced by the business of government. Some 30,000 people live in Juneau. Its total area makes it one of the biggest towns, in size, in the world. Only Kiruna, Sweden, and Sitka, Alaska, exceed Juneau’s 3,248 square miles. Today Juneau is famous not only for gold and government but also for its breathtakingly beautiful glaciers and stunning views of both water and mountains. (B, L, D)

**Day 5: Tue** – SKAGWAY, ALASKA. Arrive 6:00 am. Depart 8:30 pm. Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields for the thousands who flocked to Alaska

and the Yukon with the hope of striking it rich. Skagway may have boasted the shortest route to the Klondike, but it wasn’t the easiest. Over 100 years ago, the White Pass route through the Coast Mountains and the shorter but steeper Chilkoot Trail were used by countless stamperers. Many a would-be miner perished on the treacherous Chilkoot Trail. The gold rush was a boon and by 1898, Skagway was Alaska’s largest town with a population of about 20,000. Hotels, saloons, dance halls, and gambling houses prospered. But when the gold yield dwindled in 1900, so did the population as miners quickly shifted to new finds in Nome. Today, Skagway has less than 1,000 residents. It still retains the flavor of the gold rush era. (B, L, D)

**Day 6: Wed** – GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK (SCENIC CRUISING). Arrive 6:00 am. Depart 2:30 pm. Princess is one of a select few cruise lines permitted to cruise the pristine waters of Glacier Bay, the highlight of our 7-day Voyage of the Glaciers cruise. Just west of Juneau, this breathtaking national park and preserve boasts some of the world’s most spectacular tidewater glaciers, such as Margerie Glacier, which often drops colossal chunks of ice into the sea. Not surprisingly, Glacier Bay National Park and its epic ice giants are part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site comprising Alaska’s magnificent park system. During your scenic cruise, friendly Park Rangers will join the ship to share their knowledge of this amazing place and host a fun Junior Ranger program for kids. They may even be able to help you identify Glacier Bay’s abundant wildlife, including humpback whales, sea otters, porpoises, harbor seals, black bears, mountain goats, bald eagles, and large colonies of seabirds. Take in the awe-inspiring scenery as you enjoy an unforgettable day of sailing through this dazzling park, where you’ll glide along emerald waters and past calving icebergs, and can breathe in the crisp, fresh air to your heart’s content. **Day 7: Thur** – KETCHIKAN, ALASKA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 1:15 pm. Ketchikan is known as Alaska’s “First City” because it’s the first major community travelers come to as they journey north. Located on an island,

Ketchikan began life as an Indian fishing camp. The name Ketchikan comes from a Tlingit phrase that means “eagle with spread-out wings,” a reference to a waterfall near town. In the early 1900s, when gold was Alaska’s claim to fame, fishing and timber industries were established in Ketchikan. The growth of these industries helped make this Inside Passage port Alaska’s fourth-largest city. Visitors to Ketchikan will be intrigued by its rich Native heritage, which includes the world’s oldest collection of totem poles at Totem Heritage Center. The Haida, Tlingit, and Tsimshian are all a part of the city’s colorful history. Ketchikan, with its abundance of salmon, is also a sport-fishing paradise. Sightseers will be impressed with both the scenic town and its surroundings, especially Misty Fjords National Monument. (B, L, D)

**Day 8: Fri** – VICTORIA, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA. Arrive 9:00 pm. Depart 11:59 pm. Victoria exudes old-world charm and fragrant, colorful flowers are everywhere. Founded in 1843 by James Douglas of the Hudson’s Bay Company, the city was first known as Fort Victoria. By 1848, Vancouver Island was a British colony and Victoria was its capital. In 1858, Victoria was a tent city and the base for some 25,000 prospectors on their way to the Fraser River gold fields. When Vancouver Island was incorporated with mainland British Columbia in 1868, Victoria became the capital of the entire province. Although it’s a port city, Victoria is not as industrially oriented as Vancouver. The harbors, especially Inner Harbour, are dotted with pleasure craft, ferries and floatplanes. The city is renowned for its beautiful gardens, charming houses and very British feel. (B, L, D)

**Day 9: Sat** – SEATTLE, WASHINGTON, UNITED STATES – DISEMBARK ROYAL PRINCESS – HONOLULU. Disembark the Royal Princess. Half-day city tour. Enjoy a stop at Pike Place Market on the way to the airport. Depart Seattle. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
