Day 3: Sun, Feb 15 – SANTIAGO, CHILE – EMBARK MARINA. Arrive Santiago. Transfer to pier and embark Marina. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Mon, Feb 16 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Tue, Feb 17 – PUERTO MONTT, CHILE. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Enjoy the Bavarian ambiance of the Lake District as you visit the edge of the Patagonian wilderness, seeing pristine wood forests, vast lakes, soaring waterfalls, snow-capped peaks, and spectacular vistas. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Wed, Feb 18 – CASTRO, CHILE. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Discover the pastoral beauty of Chile's Chiloé Archipelago and lose yourself in the charming villages on Chiloé Island, where the port of Castro is the largest town and island capital. Here you'll find one of the 16 wooden churches built by Jesuit and Franciscan Catholics from the 17th to 19th centuries that together compose a UNESCO World Heritage site. Castro is also fairly close to Chiloé National Park, where you can find hiking trails to suit all levels of fitness. If you want to load up on carbs before you go, be sure to have some potatoes – varieties grown on Chiloé Island are among the oldest cultivated tubers in the world. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Thur, Feb 19 – PUERTO CHACABUCO, CHILE. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Experience a bit of rugged Patagonia with a drive into the Andes Mountains through a stunning valley to the Rio Simpson National Reserve and the town of Coyhaique. Or visit the magnificent private Aikén del Sur Park with its many waterfalls, wetlands, forests, and mosses. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Fri, Feb 20 – CRUISING THE CHILEAN FJORDS. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Sat, Feb 21 – CRUISING THE CHILEAN FJORDS. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Sun, Feb 22 – PUNTA ARENAS, CHILE. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Explore the town and its history and enjoy stunning views over the Strait of Magellan to fabled Tierra del Fuego. Discover the scenic Patagonian countryside and visit a local sheep farm. The highlight is the Magellanic Penguin rookery at Otway Sound. (B, L, D)

Day 22: Fri, Mar 06 – BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA. Arrive 7:00 pm. Overnight in Port. Discover this elegant city and its beautiful surroundings with a tranquil cruise through the Tigre Delta past islands, mansions, and English gardens. Visit the pampas and watch gauchos display their extraordinary horsemanship, or enjoy a fabulous tango show in its birthplace. (B, L, D)
