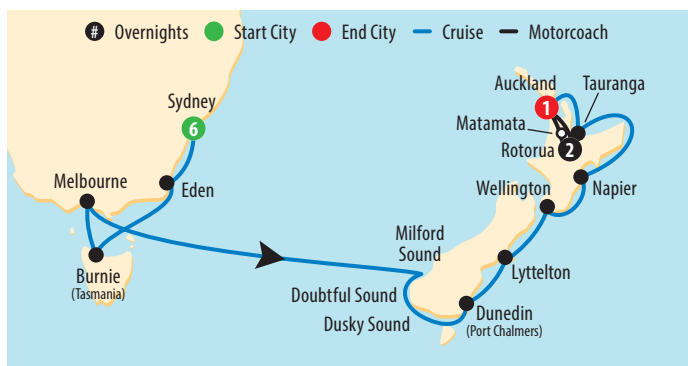

Day 16: Tue, Feb 17 – LYTTTELTON, NEW ZEALAND. 9:00 am – 7:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Wed, Feb 18 – WELLINGTON, NEW ZEALAND. 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Sat, Feb 21 – AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND – DISEMBARK NORWEGIAN SPIRIT – MATAMATA – ROTORUA. Your Tour Director will greet you upon disembarkation at the Port of Auckland. Take a scenic drive to Matamata and visit the **Hobbiton Movie Set** from *The Lord of the Rings* and *The Hobbit* films. During your visit, see the hobbit holes, the Green Dragon Inn, and other structures built for the movies. Continue to Rotorua. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. NOVOTEL LAKESIDE ROTORUA (2 Nights) (B, L, D)

Day 21: Sun, Feb 22 – ROTORUA. The morning, visit the **Te Wairoa Buried Village**. Then meet New Zealand's indigenous people when you visit an authentic **Maori village**. After the welcoming ceremony, enjoy **Maori cultural performances**, including traditional song and dance performances, discover Maori arts and crafts, and ancient rituals. Join your hosts at a **hāngī dinner** tonight, featuring slow-cooked meats and vegetables roasted in an underground earthen oven. (B, D)

Day 22: Mon, Feb 23 – ROTORUA – AUCKLAND. After breakfast, travel to the green pastoral region of Waikato to the famous **Waitomo Glowworm Caves**. Experience a guided tour through the limestone chambers and passages of the cavern. Take a silent boat trip through **Glowworm Grotto** as you glide quietly beneath the lights of thousands of glowworms suspended from the cave ceiling. Continue to Auckland. Explore the **Auckland War Memorial Museum** and **Auckland Domain**, the city's oldest park. Visit the **Sky Tower**, the tallest man-made structure in New Zealand. Here you will ascend to the observation deck for sweeping views of the "City of Sails," situated on an isthmus between two magnificent harbour. Tonight, enjoy a **dinner cruise on Auckland Harbour**. SKYCITY AUCKLAND or Similar (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 23: Tue, Feb 24 – AUCKLAND – HONOLULU. Set on the Auckland waterfront on Okahu Bay, **Kelly Tarlton's Sea Life Aquarium** is one of the city's top attractions. Explore 30 live animal exhibits in spectacular habitat displays, including the world's largest Antarctic penguin colony exhibit and amazing underwater viewing tunnels. Enjoy a harbourside lunch, with free time for shopping before transferring to the Auckland airport for the flight home. Depart via Hawaiian Airlines flt #846 at 11:30 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 9:10 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B, L)
