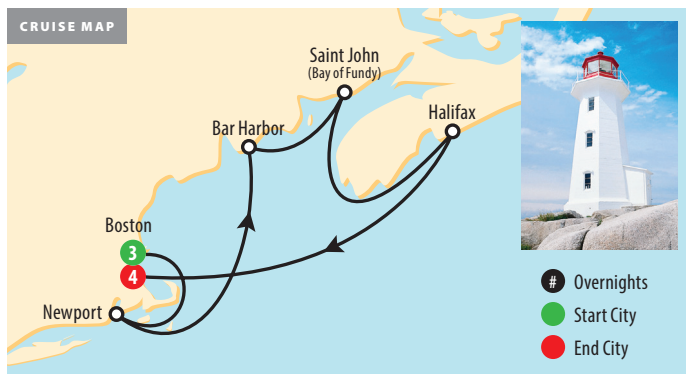

Day 1: Wed, Oct 07 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Thur, Oct 08 – BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS. Welcome to Boston! After meeting your Tour Director at the airport, make a stop at a local restaurant for breakfast. Modern Boston fades into the past as you visit the sights of the American Revolution, including visits to nearby **Colonial Lexington** and time at **Buckman Tavern** to learn about revolutionary events that happened here before continuing to Concord, another site of the first military engagement of the Revolution. Return to Boston for lunch at a local restaurant and a tour of the **Old North Church**. Continue to the site of the **Boston Tea Party** at the waterfront and sail through time on a **relaxing harbor cruise** on Boston Harbor in Massachusetts Bay— an active port for more than 400 years! Day 3: Fri, Oct 09 – BOSTON. For your day of leisure enjoy the use of the **Hop-On, Hop-Off Boston Trolley**. Enjoy lunch at a traditional Colonial Style restaurant served New England-style with true Yankee hospitality. Dine in an atmosphere that has maintained its 18th century ambiance, furnished with oversized wingback chairs and couches by the fireplace, and vintage brass beer taps and rum barrels. Afternoon at **Old Sturbridge Village**, the largest living history museum in New England. Meet farm animals, marvel at the skilled artisans, stroll through gardens, and listen to roaming minstrels. Return to Boston for an evening of leisure. (B, L)

Day 5: Sun, Oct 11 – BOSTON – EMBARK NORWEGIAN BREAKAWAY. Transfer to the Pier. Board the luxurious Norwegian Breakaway. Enjoy the Sail Away Party! (B, D)

Visit the museum exhibits, stroll through the working shipyard, and interact with storytellers in a recreated New England coastal village to learn about America's seafaring heritage. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Return to Boston for an evening of leisure. (B, L)

Day 14: Tue, Oct 20 – BOSTON. Day of leisure. Your Tour Director will be available after breakfast to assist with any help you may need in organizing your day of leisure. (B)

Day 15: Wed, Oct 21 – BOSTON. EXCURSION TO CAPE COD. Today, coach to the old fishing port of **Provincetown** on the tip of Cape Cod, now an eclectic seaside town. Browse the colorful shops and art galleries of Commercial Street and enjoy some local seafood while enjoying the beautiful ocean views. Farewell dinner this evening. (B, D)
