Day 1: HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

- Tour #1, Tour #2 & Tour #3 will depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #71 at 4:35 pm.
- Tour #4 will depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 12:45 pm.

Day 2: HANEDA — TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel. SHERATON GRANDE TOKYO BAY HOTEL (3 Nights) (D)

- Tour #1, Tour #2 & Tour #3 will arrive at 7:45 pm. Enjoy a bento dinner at the hotel.
- Tour #4 will arrive at 3:55 pm. Enjoy a buffet dinner at the hotel.

Day 3: TOKYO DISNEYLAND. After a sumptuous Japanese/Western buffet breakfast, enjoy a full day at **Tokyo Disneyland**! Group members will transfer to the resort together. Group members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort Line. (B)

Day 4: TOKYO DISNEYSEA. After breakfast, transfer to **Tokyo DisneySea** for a full day of fun and wonder. A unique park that's only found in Japan, Tokyo DisneySea was inspired by the myths and legends of the sea. Group members will transfer to the resort together. Group members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort Line. (B)

*Baggage will be sent from Tokyo to Osaka, skipping Hakone. Prepare an overnight bag for one night.

Day 5: TOKYO — HAKONE. After breakfast at the hotel, depart Tokyo for Hakone. Visit **Oshino Hakkai**, a set of eight ponds located in the Fuji Five Lake Region. The eight ponds are fed by melting snow from the nearby slopes of Mt. Fuji. The melted snow filtered down through porous layers of lava for 80 years creates a very clear spring water that is revered by the locals. Next to one pond, visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source. Continue to Hakone, where much of the area is considered an active volcanic zone since its creation from eruption of Mt. Hakone some 3,000 years ago. Enjoy a **boat ride on the beautiful Lake Ashi**. Transfer to the hotel for a buffet dinner. Then have a relaxing soak in the **onsen hot springs** — which are divided for men and women — whether indoors or outdoors. The high-quality service and facilities are sure to become some of your fondest memories of your visit to Japan. HAKONE HOTEL KOWAKIEN (1 Night) (B, L, D)

Day 6: HAKONE – KYOTO – OSAKA. After breakfast, board your waiting coach and travel to the Odawara Station. Board your **JR Super Express Train** for your ride to Kyoto Train Station. Enjoy a bento lunch onboard. Upon arrival in Kyoto, embark on a half-day of sightseeing beginning with a visit to **Kinkakuji Temple (Golden Pavilion)**, a Zen Temple whose top two floors are completely covered in gold leaf. Next, visit **Toei Kyoto Studio Park**, the only theme park in Japan where you can observe the filming of jidaigeki (period drama) films that are usually set during the Edo period (1603–1868). You can walk freely around the Toei Studio film set, which depicts a street from the Edo period, and is used to shoot more than 200 films per year. Transfer to the hotel in Osaka, where the rest of your evening is at your leisure. The Local Guide will have many suggestions for dinner and shopping. Universal Citywalk Osaka is an entertainment and shopping complex jam-packed with unique and fascinating restaurants and stores, located





outside Universal Studios Japan — just a short walk from your hotel. HOTEL UNIVERSAL PORT VITA (2 Nights) (B, L)

Day 7: OSAKA. After breakfast, walk to **Universal Studios Japan**. Enjoy a full day of attractions and entertainment, including *The Wizarding World of Harry Potter* and *Super Nintendo World!* With the hotel located conveniently close by, you can maximize your time in the park and stay the entire day if you wish. Return to the hotel at your leisure. (B)

Day 8: OSAKA — KANSAI — HONOLULU. After breakfast, depart the hotel for a day of shopping! Begin at **Kuromon Ichiba Market**, a lively covered market which stretches for 580 meters in Osaka's Chuo Ward. The market is famous for its fresh seafood, fruits and vegetables, meats, dried fish, pickles, and confectionery. It is an excellent place to stroll, sample, and snack on a delicious variety of fresh market foods. Then visit Dotonbori and Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade, a couple of Osaka's most popular tourist destinations. **Dotonbori** runs parallel to the Dotonbori Canal and is a popular shopping and entertainment district and is also known as a food destination. Approximately 600 meters long, **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** and the surrounding area is Osaka's premier shopping center. The area is unique as it combines chain retail stores and trendy boutiques with department stores and top designer fashion labels. Enjoy lunch in the area (on your own). Finally, stop at an **AEON MALL** for even more shopping, before departing for the Kansai Airport for the return flight home. Depart Kansai Airport via Japan Airlines flt #792 at 10:05 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 11:00 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
